Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following:

- Specify, locate and recommend potential Vehicles & Generators for acquisition.
- Build, Fabricate and/or Modify equipment as needed including Commercial and Delivery Vehicles, Generators and Trailers.
- Fabricate equipment for warehouse or general rental inventory as required.
- Maintain and administer current and up to date computer programming of OnTrack (Generator Logic) Generators
- Oversee and participate in the Servicing and Repair of Generators as required by the company on a scheduled program.
- Oversee and participate in the Servicing and Repair of Commercial and Delivery Vehicles as required by the company on a scheduled program.
- Prepare and submit as needed repair summaries for Vehicles and Generators on a weekly basis to the Transportation Manager and the COO for evaluation and approval.
- Prepare and submit purchase request to the Purchasing Agent for parts and supplies needed in your area except for instances that may require your visual verification to insure the right item.
- Be on call 24/7 with regard to Generator and Vehicle emergencies.
- Communicate directly with President as needed in regards to company sensitive situations (i.e. OnTrack, ESPN) and in emergency situations that may arise (i.e. operator issues on location, roadside emergencies from drivers, etc.)
- Communicate directly with the Director of Broadcast & Technical Services as needed in regards to operational and emergency issues as they may arise including situations that may affect broadcast customers directly.
- Perform as needed on site visits to audit, inspect and insure generators and electrical distribution is being used correctly and in accordance with ID's policies.
- Insure that all service records are being diligently kept in an organized fashion in accordance with company policies and procedures.
- Works together with President and COO to determine new inventory needs.
- Interact with crew and clients as needed to insure customer satisfaction.

- Maintain Class A Driver's License with clean record & current medical card.
- Extensive Electrical and Electronic knowledge including AC & DC Power, Generators, and ability to analyze problems and perform repairs.
- Ability to read wiring schematics.

- Extensive knowledge of diesel and gasoline engines.
- Extensive knowledge of complete mechanical operation of vehicles and ability to repair.
- Ability to troubleshoot and make repairs in the shop and on location.
- Ability to troubleshoot and assist operators in the field via phone with repair guidance.
- Work as driver and/or generator operator on location.
- Must possess good welding and cutting skills as they apply to building and fabrication.
- Knowledge of current technological developments/trends as they apply to our industries.
- Ability to gather data, compile information, and prepare reports.
- Skill in organizing resources and establishing priorities.
- Knowledge of customer service standards and procedures.
- Good Knowledge of rental equipment terminology and application as it applies to the Motion Picture, Broadcast and Special Event Industries.
- Knowledge in the use of personal computers and related company software applications.
- Ability to develop and maintain record keeping systems and procedures.
